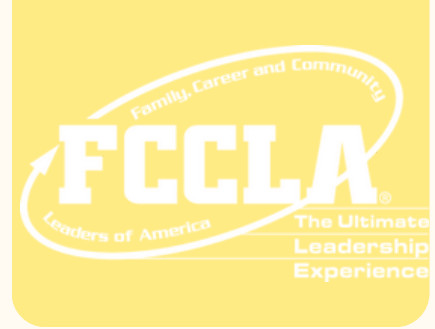

STATE SENDOFF

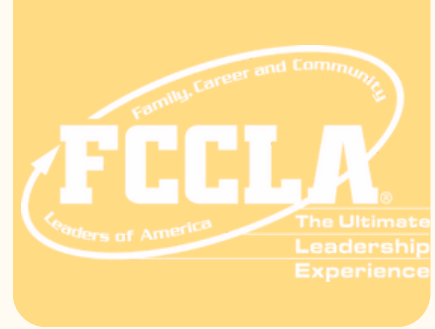
